By passing the cardiac auscultation and patella clinic, your Bulldog is eligible to receive the Division IV Ambassador for Health Silver Level award and CHIC, Canine Health Information Center Number, which is the program used by Bulldog Club of America.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: As a cost-saving measure for the club, confirmation letters (the judging program) will be distributed to exhibitors via email. If you would like your confirmation physically mailed to you, please make that notation on your entries.

Entries will not be accepted without fees. FAX and email entries will not be accepted. Entries must include both sides of the official AKC entry form.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The show secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. All fees are payable in US funds. Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

JR. SHOWMANSHIP

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For boys and girls who are at least 10 years old and under 14 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For boys and girls who are at least 14 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For boys and girls who are at least 10 years old and under 14 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For boys and girls who are at least 14 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show with competition present.

NOTE - Be sure all information for Jr. Showmanship classes is entered on front and back of entry form. By signing the entry form, certification is given that the Jr. Showman does not now, and will not at anytime, act as an agent/handler for pay while continuing to compete in Junior Showmanship.

DIXIE L. LITTLE TROPHY

The Dixie L. Little trophy will be awarded at the Lone Star Bulldog Club Specialty Show, Saturday, March 13, 2010, to the Best of Breed Winner, if the winner is the breeder/owner/exhibitor. The year, name of the dog and the name of the breeder/owner/exhibitor will be engraved on plates that will be affixed to the trophy.

Permanent possession of the Dixie L. Little trophy will be awarded if the trophy is won three times by the same breeder/owner/exhibitor, but not necessarily with the same Bulldog.

Lone Star Bulldog Club unveiled this trophy in 2007 to celebrate Dixie's 50th year of membership.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The show room will be available to exhibitors at NOON THURSDAY, MARCH 11, 2010. The show room will be closed after each show, Thursday – Sunday. All dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following each day. A crating area will be available. **NO CRATES ALLOWED RINGSIDE.**

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. The clubs will not be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

The clubs reserve the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - none will be mailed.

BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR ELIGIBILITY

All dogs entered in the Bred-By class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

RETURNED CHECKS

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fees. The show secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the show committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the clubs.

The show giving clubs, their agents, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes any responsibility for injury to children. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by email prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

The Texas Dept. of Health requires that all dogs three months or older have a current rabies vaccination certificate. Please bring your certificate, as tags do not constitute proof of vaccination. Dogs without current certificates are subject to 30 days quarantine.

Not picking up after your dog may result in an AKC misconduct hearing and disciplinary action. Per sections 1 & 2 of AKC's Dealing with Misconduct, Lone Star Bulldog Club and Fort Worth Bulldog Club reserve the right to retain show committee jurisdiction over exhibitors whose name(s) have been referred by the hotel for having left their ROOMS and/or GROUNDS in a state that appears negligent or offensive. Should it be determined that misuse has occurred, these steps will be taken.

The offender will make monetary restitution immediately to the hotel/motel. The person or persons found in violation of the hotel and AKC rules will be asked to leave the grounds immediately. If suspended by AKC and found guilty, the offenders' names will be published in the AKC Gazette and the Bulldogger.

Dogs may arrive at any time prior to the scheduled time of judging, within the published show hours. The judge will adhere to the judging schedule, and is not required to wait for dogs. Lone Star Bulldog Club, Fort Worth Bulldog Club and the show secretary have no obligation or responsibility for calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. All dogs must be kept on leash or otherwise kept under control except while being judged.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The show secretary will add a collection fee of \$35 to the amount of each returned check. Owners are responsible for errors in filling out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing time.

Entries not on official AKC entry forms, or copies of same without the agreement and rules on the reverse side are not acceptable. A recording fee of 50 cents and \$3.00 for AKC's event services is included in the entry fee, and will be paid by the show-giving club to the American Kennel Club.

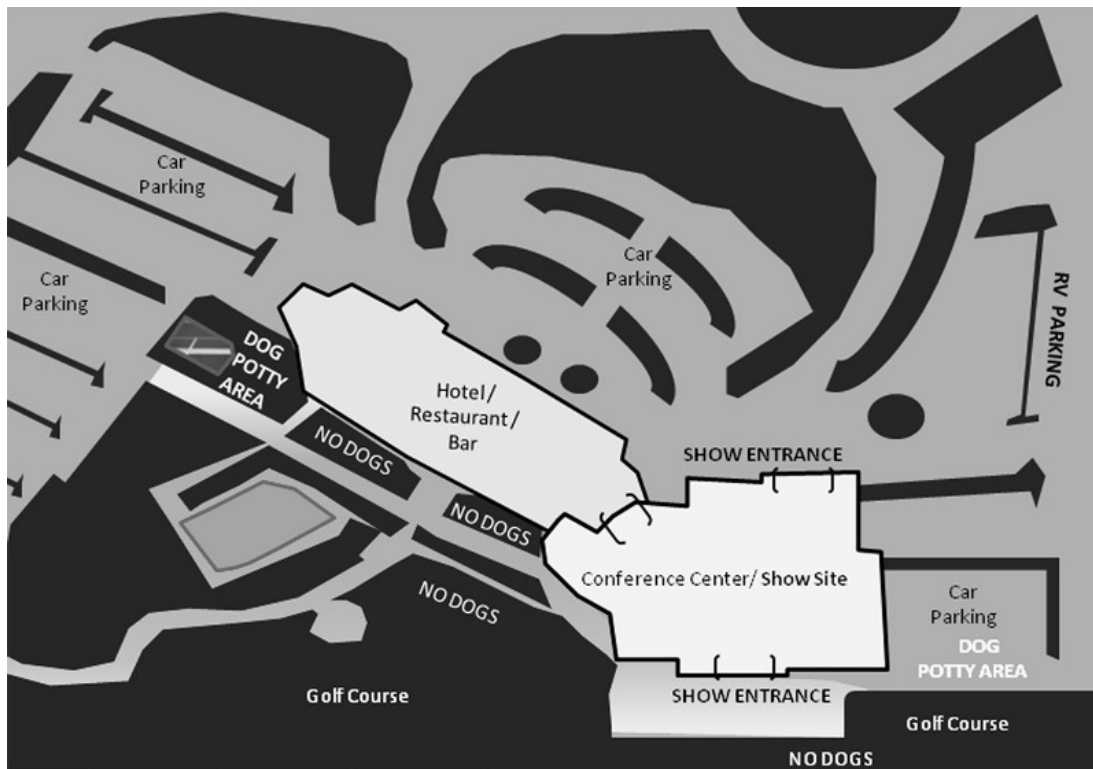

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Registration and Dog Shows" and, if this entry is for an obedience trial the "Obedience Regulations," have been made available to me (us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (we) waive any and all claims, causes of action; I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC approved judge, judging at this show, under AKC Rules, Regulations and Guidelines. I (we) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the club shall deem to be sufficient.
